RESCHEDULED COUNCIL WORK SESSION

The City Council of the City of Gulf Shores, Alabama met in a Council Work Session Meeting on Monday, July 5, 2016 at 4:00 p.m. with Mayor Craft presiding. The meeting was held at City Hall.

Upon roll call, the following members answered present: Councilman Harris, Jones and Mayor Craft. The meeting was called to order.

1. Councilman Discussion Period – Councilman Jones

Councilman Jones reported he and Ed Rodriguez had met with the owner of Beach House Kitchen Restaurant to discuss Spring Break economic issues and subsequent results and impacts, including possible future impacts, on the business community.

A Spring Break Town Hall type meeting has been proposed to gather industry partners, retail merchants, beach service, restaurants, bars and other businesses to “get their take” on the economic impact caused by the response initiated by the Council to ensure public safety including prohibiting possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages on all beaches during the Spring Break season. Mayor Craft stated he wanted to make sure the appropriate staff was available, along with the council members; further stating residents should also be included. The proposed date for this meeting is Tuesday, July 12 at 9:00 a.m.


