The City Council of the City of Gulf Shores, Alabama met in a Council Work Session Meeting on Monday, September 6, 2016 at 4:00 p.m. with Mayor Craft presiding. The meeting was held at City Hall.

Upon roll call, the following members answered present: Councilman Doughty, Harris, Jones and Mayor Craft. Councilman Garris and Dyken were absent. The meeting was called to order.

At this time, Mayor Craft announced Phase 1 of the Gulf Place Redevelopment Project had started. The \$15M project will be a revitalization of Gulf Place in accordance with the Vision 2025 Plan the City adopted last year to improve parking, public safety and pedestrian access and use.

Local citizen, Stephen Kichler, voiced his concerns regarding money being spent redeveloping Gulf Place and tourism. Mr. Kichler suggests the Council make local citizen issues a priority such as, reduced rates at the fitness center, allow sponsors for city sports teams to reduce rates, and restoring the environmental health and water quality of Little Lagoon.

Environmental Grants Coordinator Dan Bond addressed Mr. Kichler’s concerns, stating he was aware of the issues at Little Lagoon and was working with several different agencies on a lagoon watershed management plan, habitat restoration and a State sponsored septic tank pump out voucher program which would be available in 2017.

A local resident inquired as to how the traffic lights performed during the holiday weekend. Director of Public Works Mark Acreman stated they had done well in heavy traffic and were being monitored daily by a fully trained designated employee assigned specifically to that task and tweak as needed to improve traffic flow.

Dr. Lawrence Phipps, Interim Pastor of First Baptist Church of Gulf Shores, announced the church plans to honor and show their appreciation to our local first responders by providing lunch to both the police and fire departments in recognition of the 15<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the 9/11 terror attack on the United States.
