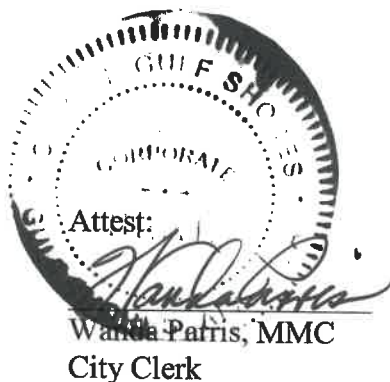
1. Councilman Discussion Period – Councilman Jason Dyken, M.D. – None at this time.
