

City of Gulf Shores Public Beach Parking Pay Stations



What to know...

- The City of Gulf Shores has implemented a pay-by-space parking system at some public beach locations. Fees for parking convenience are being charged at [Gulf Place](#) (main public beach), [West 2nd Street](#), and [West 6th Street](#) parking lots.
- Parking Fees are:
 - \$1.00 per hour for up to four (4) hours
 - \$5.00 for 12 hours
- The Pay Stations accept cash, coins, and credit cards, but DO NOT issue change.
- Gulf Shores residents MAY park in the paid parking lots for no charge. Hurricane re-entry decals or beach parking passes serve as a resident parking permit.
- The City of Gulf Shores Parking Ordinance does not provide for the sale of any season beach passes this year. Seasonal beach passes are no longer available for tourists and non-residents.
- Parking enforcement officers will check each vehicle for either a current Hurricane Re-Entry decal or, if you live north of the canal, a current beach parking decal. These parking enforcement officers will know which spaces should be vacant, and if neither decal is present on the vehicle occupying the space, a parking citation will be issued.

Please be aware that there are many public parking areas which do not require any fee to be paid. The City of Gulf Shores website has a [map showing these alternate locations](#).
