

City of Gulf Shores Public Beach Parking Pay Stations



What to know...

- The City of Gulf Shores pay-by-space parking system has been reinstalled at 3 public beach parking locations. Fees for parking convenience are being charged at [Gulf Place](#) (main public beach), [West 2nd Street](#), and [West 6th Street](#) parking lots.
- Parking Fee is \$5.00 per day.
- Each payment receipt will have a date printed on it that will allow you access to the paid parking area(s) for the entire day of purchase. Though an individual *parking space* is not reserved for the day, access to available spaces in the lot is granted for the valid date on the receipt. Patrons should display this receipt on the dashboard of their vehicle so parking attendants can clearly see all information on the receipt.
- The Pay Stations accept cash, coins, and credit cards, but DO NOT issue change.
- Gulf Shores residents MAY park in the paid parking lots for no charge. Your Hurricane re-entry decals serve as a resident parking permit.
- The City of Gulf Shores Parking Ordinance does not provide for the sale of any season beach passes this year. Seasonal beach passes are no longer available for purchase.
- Parking enforcement officers will check each vehicle for either a current Hurricane Re-Entry decal or a valid parking receipt.

Please be aware that there are many public parking areas which do not require any fees to be paid. The City of Gulf Shores website has a [map showing these alternate locations](#).
