

## **MINUTES OF SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING**

### **CITY OF GULF SHORES, ALABAMA**

**May 25, 2010**

The City Council of the City of Gulf Shores, Alabama, met in special session on Tuesday, May 25, 2010. Mayor Craft called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. Corporal Billy Berrey, Juvenile Officer with Gulf Shores Police Department delivered the invocation. The Pledge of Allegiance was lead by Mayor Craft.

Upon roll call, the following officials answered "present;" Councilman Garris, Councilman Dyken, Councilman Jones and Mayor Craft. Councilman Doughty and Councilman Harris were absent. The Mayor stated that a quorum was present and that the meeting was open for the transaction of business.

The Mayor then stated that due notice of the time, place and purpose of this meeting had been given to all members of the City Council and that each member had signed the acceptance of service of said notice, waiving all irregularities, if any, in said notice. The notice and acceptance of service and waiver signed by each member was ordered inserted in the minutes of this meeting at the end thereof.

At this time Mayor Craft welcomed newly appointed Police Chief Edward Delmore and his wife, Ann to the City of Gulf Shores. Chief Delmore stated that he and his family were happy to be in Gulf Shores and that they looked forward to becoming a part of the community.

Judge Walter Chandler administered the Oath of Office to Chief of Police Delmore. The documents were signed by both officials and submitted to the City Clerk for the record.

There being no further business to come before the Council at this time, Councilman Jones moved to adjourn; seconded by Councilman Garris; and the vote of those officials present was unanimously in favor of the motion.
