

The municipal jail for the City of Gulf Shores is located at the Gulf Shores Police Department, at 220 Clubhouse Drive in Gulf Shores. The jail houses prisoners sentenced for violations and misdemeanors in Gulf Shores. Persons who commit felony offenses are held at the Baldwin County Correctional Facility in Bay Minette, Alabama.

Persons incarcerated at the Gulf Shores Jail are provided with items needed for their stay. With few exceptions, items are not allowed to be brought to the prisoner. If you have concerns or need to check if they may receive an item please call the Gulf Shores Police and ask for corrections. The number to call is (251) 968-2431. Please remember that legal questions about a charge should be directed to the court in Gulf Shores, but questions about the person or items they may need or receive should be directed to the corrections officer.

Visiting hours are on Wednesday from 9 AM to 10 AM and 6 PM to 7 PM. Any person may visit a prisoner however please be prepared to provide ID or basic information on arrival for the visit. Additionally, prisoners may send and receive mail while here.
