BAY STREET BRASSWORKS

Bay Street Brassworks (YAMAHA Performing Artists) is one of America's finest brass ensembles. Founded in 1995, this versatile quintet performs a wide variety of musical genres ranging from classical music to Dixieland jazz, show tunes, classic rock, movie music, and anything in between. In addition to extensive concert activities, Bay Street Brassworks released their first CD in 2002, entitled "Fresh Off The Boat – Folk Music From

Around The World", and their second CD "American Escapades" in 2006. These recordings have expanded the reach of the ensemble into homes and schools from Florida to Colorado and from Maryland to Korea.

This Baltimore-based group's musical abilities have produced engagements ranging from opening ceremonies at Baltimore Orioles baseball games to world premier performances & clinics alongside the American Brass Quintet, Harvey Phillips, Gunther Schuller & Eric Ewazen at the 2004 Brass Chamber Music Forum in Boone, NC, honoring the 50th anniversary of the New York Brass Quintet.
