

RESOLUTION NO. -23

**A RESOLUTION
ACCEPTING THE BID OF
MCELHENNEY CONSTRUCTION
IN THE AMOUNT OF \$538,318.77 FOR
MAST ARMS TRAFFIC SIGNAL AND PEDESTRIAN CROSSWALK
LOCATED AT WEST 2ND STREET & STATE HWY 180 AND
AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF CONTRACT NOT TO EXCEED \$550,000.00**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GULF SHORES, ALABAMA, WHILE IN REGULAR SESSION ON JANUARY 23, 2023, as follows:

Section 1. That the bid of McElhenney Construction in the amount of \$538,318.77 to construct a new mast-arm traffic signal and pedestrian crosswalk located at the intersection of West 2nd Street & State Hwy 180, be and the same is hereby accepted, being the lowest, most responsible, among sealed bids opened on December 13, 2022. Since this is a unit bid contract, Engineering recommends the contract be awarded for an amount not to exceed \$550,000.00.

Section 2. That the Mayor and City Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and directed to execute and attest, respectively, a contract between the City of Gulf Shores and McElhenney Construction; in substantially the form presented to Council this date.

Section 3. That the City originally budgeted a span-wire traffic signal for this intersection due to overhead powerline conflicts for \$250,000 in FY2023 Account #42-879-80911 Ft Morgan Access Management. Baldwin EMC has since committed to relocate the overhead powerline to allow for a mast-arm traffic signal. Engineering has requested and additional \$350,000 be transferred from the Account #42-879-65560, Pedestrian Bridge, to Account #42-879-80911 in Budget Amendment #1 to cover the additional expense to install a mast-arm signal.

Section 4. That this Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.
