

RESOLUTION NO. -23

A RESOLUTION  
AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY USE PERMIT FOR TEMPORARY OFFICES  
FOR ALDOT AND SCOTT BRIDGE COMPANY

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BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GULF SHORES, ALABAMA, WHILE IN REGULAR SESSION ON JANUARY 23, 2023, as follows:

**Section 1.** Therefore, in accordance with Article 6-7.5. *Temporary Buildings and Uses* of the Zoning Ordinance, the request of Scott Bridge Company for a temporary use permit to place temporary office trailers on property located at 22171 Cotton Creek Drive, Gulf Shores, Alabama, to be used as a project office trailer for ALDOT and a project office trailer for Scott Bridge Company to facilitate the construction of the new ALDOT Vehicular Bridge and roadway is hereby approved subject to certain conditions and requirements between the City, Scott Bridge Company, and ALDOT as deemed necessary and in substantially the form presented to Council this date.

**Section 2.** That issuance of a three (3) year temporary use permit for Scott Bridge Company to erect two temporary office trailers with security fencing and gravel parking area as depicted on the site plan submitted on 1/19/2023 to facilitate the construction of the new ALDOT Vehicular Bridge and roadway is hereby authorized, ratified, and confirmed subject to the following requirement:

- In the event of any material violation of the approved use of the site as depicted on the site plan submitted on 1/19/2023, as determined by the City Council after temporary use permit approval, the City Council shall have the right in its sole and absolute discretion to revoke the temporary use permit hereby approved. Such revocation shall be effective upon thirty (30) days notice sent to Scott Bridge Company.

**Section 3.** That this Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.
