**A RESOLUTION
AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE
EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE
BALDWIN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, MUNICIPAL JURISDICTIONS,
OTHER ORGANIZATIONS AND THE CITY OF GULF SHORES REGARDING THE
THE BALDWIN COUNTY EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN (EOP)**

WHEREAS, that The Baldwin County Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) is an all-discipline, all-hazards plan that establishes a single, comprehensive framework for the management of domestic incidents. It provides the structure and mechanisms for the coordination of County support to local and state incident managers and for exercising direct county authorities and responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, that the EOP assists in the important missions of preventing terrorist attacks, reducing the vulnerability to all natural and manmade hazards, minimizing the damage and suffering caused by any disaster, and assisting in the recovery from any type of incident that occurs.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GULF SHORES, ALABAMA WHILE IN REGULAR SESSION ON MARCH 13, 2023 as follows:

Section 1. That the City Council of the City of Gulf Shores hereby authorizes and approves the Agreement with the Baldwin County Commissioner's Office, Municipal Jurisdictions, Other Organizations and the City of Gulf Shores to commit to the Baldwin County Emergency Operations Plan (EOP).

Section 2. That the Mayor and City Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and directed to execute and attest, respectively, all documents necessary to ensure the City's participation in the Agreement in substantially the form presented to Council this date.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.
