## COUNCIL AGENDA SUMMARY

**DATE:** 03/18/2019

**SUBJECT:** Structure Fire Automatic-Aid Agreement between City of Gulf Shores Department of Fire and Emergency Services and City of Foley Fire Department.

**BACKGROUND:** Gulf Shores and Foley Fire departments currently operate under a Mutual-Aid Agreement requiring each department to request assistance at the time of a structure fire. I.S.O. has reviewed each department and recommends we enter into an Automatic-Aid Agreement with-in the designated geographical areas listed below:

**1. Gulf Shores Fire Auto Response Area into Foley:**

- a. County Road 10 extending from Richard Childress Lane westward to the intersection of County Road 10 and County Road 65 and all areas within and adjacent to that boundary

**2. Foley Fire Auto-Response in to Gulf Shores:**

- a. Coastal Gateway Boulevard and all areas within and adjacent to that boundary not to extend further south than the southern boundary of Craft Farms North.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Approval of the Automatic-Aid Agreement between Gulf Shores and Foley.

**PREVIOUS COUNCIL ACTION:** Automatic-Aid agreements already approved with Fort Morgan VFD, Oyster Bay VFD and Orange Beach Fire Department.

**BUDGET IMPLICATIONS:** None
