

Automatic Aid Agreement
Structure Fire Response
City of Foley Fire Department - City of Gulf Shores Fire Department

1. For the benefit of the citizens of our communities this automatic aid agreement is entered into by the City of Foley and the City of Gulf Shores, both operating in Baldwin County, Alabama.
2. The Baldwin County Emergency Communications District shall automatically and simultaneously dispatch The City of Foley and The City of Gulf Shores upon receipt of calls for structure fires in the following areas:
 - a. County Road 10 extending from Richard Childress Lane westward to the intersection of County Road 10 and County Road 65 and all areas within and adjacent to that boundary.
 - b. Coastal Gateway Blvd and all areas within and adjacent to that boundary not to extend further south than the southern boundary of Craft Farms North.
3. The officer on the first arriving company will take command of the incident until relieved by the appropriate authority. Overall, the Fire Department with primary jurisdiction, upon arrival at the scene, will assume command of the incident.
4. Each party agrees to assume responsibility for all liabilities that occur or arise in any way out of the performance of this agreement by its personnel and to save and hold the other party, its employees and officials, harmless from all costs, expenses, losses and damages, including cost of defense, incurred as a result of any acts or omissions of the party's employees relating to the performance of this agreement.
5. Each party agrees to maintain adequate insurance coverage for its own equipment and personnel.
6. Each party agrees to establish and conduct the following at mutually agreeable times and locations:
 - a. Standard procedures related to the safe and effective implementation of this agreement. Including but not limited to: Joint Incident Command, Communications, and Operations.
 - b. Joint training conducted quarterly as required by ISO (3 hours quarterly).
 - c. Other mutually agreeable activities that facilitate this agreement.
7. This agreement may be terminated by either party giving to the other party a thirty (30) day notice of termination in writing.
