**A RESOLUTION
ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF
FABRE ENGINEERING & SURVEYING IN AN AMOUNT NOT
TO EXCEED \$130,735.00 FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES
AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT TO PERFORM CERTAIN
ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO WEST LAGOON AVENUE**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GULF SHORES, ALABAMA, WHILE IN REGULAR SESSION ON APRIL 22, 2019, as follows:

Section 1. That the proposal from Fabre Engineering & Surveying for professional services in an amount not to exceed \$130,735.00 to provide surveying, design and inspection services to improve West Lagoon Avenue by adding 5' bike lanes, an 8' multi-use path and resurfacing. In addition, Fabre Engineering and Surveying will also provide the same professional services to extend the current multi-use path from its terminus east of the Lagoon Park Pier to West 13th St and evaluate the feasibility of constructing a roundabout at the intersection of West Lagoon Ave and Hwy 182, be and the same is hereby accepted, authorized and outlined in the Scope of Work and/or as specified for additional services; and

Section 2. That the Mayor and City Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and directed to execute and attest, respectively, a professional services agreement between the City of Gulf Shores and Fabre Engineering & Surveying in substantially the form presented to Council this date; and

Section 3. That funding for the design fees have been provided for in the 2018-A GO Warrant Transportation Bond and will be included in a forthcoming budget amendment. The debt service will be funded by the 2% Lodging Tax dedicated to transportation improvements.

Section 4. That this Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.
