SUBJECT: 2019 FEMA Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance Revision

DATE: May 2, 2019

ISSUE: The City's current Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance was reviewed by our State NFIP Coordinator and recommended amendments to meet FEMA NFIP requirements.

RECOMMENDATION: I recommend Mayor and Council adopt this ordinance with the amendments.

BACKGROUND: The City adopted an entirely new Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance to meet the FEMA requirements to participate in the National Flood Insurance Program. Our State NFIP coordinator has made recommendations to amend one section and a definition after his second review of our ordinance. The amendments do not change the intent of the ordinance and I have found them to be only minor changes.
