ISSUE: Amend 2020 Recreational Trails Program Grant Application.

RECOMMENDATIONS: Amend Resolution Authorizing staff to pursue a Recreational Trails Program grant. The City will request \$342,699.15 in grant monies to fund the enhancement and improvement of the Fort Morgan Trail.

BACKGROUND: The City applied for and has been recommended to receive a Recreational Trails Grant by ADECA to enhance and improve the Fort Morgan Trail from Callaway Rd to Peninsula Blvd. ADECA is willing to recommend the Ft. Morgan Trail Improvement Project to the Federal Highway Administration with a reduced Federal match amount of \$342,699.15 from the City's originally requested \$400,000.

The City is one of four recipients to receive approval out of twenty applications. Per ADECA, all four recipients are receiving similar grant amounts. Due to the change in funding, the City will have to amend the original resolution and resubmit the grant application with our proposed match increasing from \$100,000 to \$157,300.85.

PREVIOUS COUNCIL ACTION: The City Council accepted RTP grants in 2013 and 2015 for improvements to the Fort Morgan Trail.

BUDGET IMPLICATIONS: The total cost of this project is estimated at \$500,000, and the City would be responsible for the match share of the project, \$157,300.85, plus up-front Engineering Design costs of \$31,700. There is \$500,000 budgeted for this project in the FY 2019 in account 43-879-65500.
