SUBJECT: Authorize the surplus and trade-in of Beach Tech Beach Sweeper and purchase of new Barber Beach Rake.

DATE: 02/12/2020

RECOMMENDATION: Authorize the surplus and trade in of the 2010 Beach Tech Beach Sweeper (vehicle #3578) in the amount of \$10,000 and authorize the purchase. The funds received from the trade in will be used to offset the cost of the new Barber Beach Rake.

BACKGROUND: The city budgeted \$50,000 for the purchase of a replacement, 2020 Beach Sweeper. The purchase of the Beach Sweeper is through a HGAC contract; which is authorized and approved by the State of Alabama as being competitively bid. The final cost after the \$10,000 credit came in under budget at \$49,743.00.

BUDGET IMPLICATIONS: The purchase amount for this equipment was budgeted at \$50,000 for 2020 in account 14-879-840001.
