Subject: Bid for Sportsplex Triple Jump Runway Resurfacing

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**ISSUE:** The City of Gulf Shores Sportsplex has established an impressive sports tourism reputation at regional and national levels and currently hosts the NAIA National, AHSSA and AISA State Outdoor Track & Field Champions. More importantly, the Sportsplex greatly benefits and enhances our local high school and recreational programs offering our residents superior athletic facilities. In effort for the City to retain and attract these economically beneficial events as well as continue to offer high quality recreational amenities to its residents and student athletes ongoing maintenance is necessary to keep the highest quality and safety. The triple jump runway synthetic surface has reached its usable lifespan and now requires resurfacing.

**BACKGROUND:** Sealed bids were solicited for Mickey Miller Blackwell Stadium-Synthetic Track Runway resurfacing and opened on December 22, 2020. Geo Surfaces, Inc. submitted the sole conforming bid.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Award base bid to Geo Surfaces, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$42,000.00.

**BUDGET IMPLICATIONS:** Initial project estimated cost in the amount of \$60,000.00 was approved in the 2021 Capital Budget.
