**DATE:** March 15, 2022

**ISSUE:** Professional services proposal from Overstreet & Associates to perform design work associated with the West 6<sup>th</sup> Street Beach Access Improvements.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Accept professional services proposal for West 6<sup>th</sup> St Beach Access Improvements from Overstreet & Associates in amount not to exceed \$18,900.

**BACKGROUND:** The City received a \$50,000 ACAMP grant through the Alabama Department of Conservation and Natural Resources (ADCNR), State Lands Division, Coastal Section to perform improvements to the West 6<sup>th</sup> Street Public Beach Access through the following:

- Add an ADA parking stall to the public parking area and construct an ADA route to the boardwalk.
- Replace existing wooden boardwalk, ramp, and stairs to improve ADA accessibility to the beach.
- Replace beach shower system on boardwalk.

Overstreet & Associates has provided a proposal to provide design services for the project, including: Surveying, permitting coordination, construction plans, construction documents, and any other professional services as required by the grant agreement.

**PREVIOUS COUNCIL ACTION:** City Council approved Resolution No. 6393-21 authorizing the execution of application for the grant funding for this project.

**BUDGET IMPLICATIONS:** Funding for this professional services proposal is included in the \$200,000 budgeted for this project in FY 2022 Account #42-879-80911, Land & Improvements. \$50,000 of construction costs will be reimbursed for this project via the ADCNR grant agreement.
