**A RESOLUTION
AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE
MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE
AND ATTEST, RESPECTIVELY,
TASK ORDER 2022-02 WITH OLSEN ASSOCIATES, INC.
TO PERFORM A CULTURAL RESOURCES ASSESSMENT SURVEY
FOR WORK RELATED TO HURRICANE NATE AND HURRICANE SALLY
ENGINEERED BEACH LOSSES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$54,400.00**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GULF SHORES, ALABAMA, WHILE IN REGULAR SESSION ON MARCH 28, 2022, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor and City Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and directed to execute and attest, respectively, Task Order Memorandum 2022-02 between the City of Gulf Shores and Olsen Associates, Inc. to perform a Cultural Resources Assessment Survey for work related to Hurricane Nate and Hurricane Sally engineered beach losses in an amount not to exceed \$54,400.00; in substantially the form presented to Council this date.

Section 2. That FEMA & AEMA will reimburse 87.5% of professional services for our Engineered Beach Restoration Project which yields a net cost to the City for this Task Order of \$6,800.00. There is \$4,937,000 included in the FY 2022 Budget in Account #39-819-81710 Cat G to fund the beach restoration work.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.
