**MINUTES OF  
RESCHEDULED REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING  
CITY OF GULF SHORES, ALABAMA  
MAY 28, 2019**

Mayor Robert Craft called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. at City Hall. The invocation was delivered by Deputy Fire Chief Keith Martin.

Upon roll call, the following officials answered "present": Councilman Joe Garris, Jr., Councilman Gary M. Sinak, Councilman Jason Dyken, M.D., Councilman Stephen E. Jones and Mayor Robert Craft. Councilman Philip Harris was absent.

Councilman Joe Garris, Jr. moved to approve the minutes of the Regular Council Meeting of May 13, 2019, as presented; seconded by Councilman Gary M. Sinak was regularly put; was discussed and considered in full by the Council; and upon the question, the vote thereon was as follows: Councilman Joe Garris, Jr., "aye", Councilman Gary M. Sinak, "aye", Councilman Jason Dyken, M.D., "aye", Councilman Stephen E. Jones, "aye" and Mayor Robert Craft, "aye". Councilman Philip Harris was absent. Whereupon, Mayor Robert Craft declared the motion carried.

At this time, Councilman Jason Dyken, M.D. moved to approve the minutes of the Council Work Session Meeting of May 20, 2019, as presented; seconded by Councilman Stephen E. Jones was regularly put; was discussed and considered in full by the Council; and upon the question, the vote thereon was as follows: Councilman Joe Garris, Jr., "aye", Councilman Gary M. Sinak, "aye", Councilman Jason Dyken, M.D., "aye", Councilman Stephen E. Jones, "aye" and Mayor Robert Craft, "aye". Councilman Philip Harris was absent. Whereupon, Mayor Robert Craft declared the motion carried.

Councilman Stephen E. Jones moved to approve the expense vouchers in the amount of \$2,315,482.28 seconded by Councilman Gary M. Sinak; and the vote of those officials present was unanimously in favor of the motion.

The City Clerk noted that the complete list of vouchers to be paid, as reflected on a computer printout, had been made a permanent record in the Clerk's office.

At this time, Deputy Fire Chief Keith Martin recognized several of the lifeguards which had obtained their USLA Advanced Agency Certification and acknowledged a recent tragic drowning of a young man trying to save two other members of his family. Battalion Chief Melvin Sheppard gave a brief history of the lifeguard program and statistics of water rescues and daily visitor contact lifeguards make in the performance of their duties.

Director of Recreation and Cultural Affairs Grant Brown shared the City of Gulf Shores would be partnering with Blue Cross Blue Shield to provide 10 sunscreen dispensers located at area beaches for public use. Shelby Smith who interned with the City last summer, helped develop the sunscreen project and bring it to fruition. Blue Cross & Blue Shield representatives Clay Waldon and Will Lyles expressed their appreciation in partnering with the City on this worthwhile project. The dispensers will dispense 50spf organic sunscreen.

**Section 1.** That Chapter 21, TRAFFIC, of the Code of Ordinances, adopted July 24, 1989, be and it is hereby amended by adding certain language at Article I., In General, Section 21-7, Four-Way Stop Intersections, to include the intersections of 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Streets, so the entire Section shall read as follows:

CHAPTER 21 TRAFFIC

ARTICLE I. IN GENERAL

Sec. 21-7. Four-way stop intersections.

\* \* \*

x. The intersection of 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Streets is hereby declared henceforth to be a four way stop intersection.

STAFF REPORT:



Department Heads presented City project updates.

Gulf Shores City School Superintendent Dr. Matt Akin announced the portables in front of the elementary school had been emptied and would be moved this week. There is a Special Board Meeting Wednesday, May 29<sup>th</sup> at 3:30p.m. at the Central Office location.

At this time, numerous residents spoke in opposition to the Hangout Music Festival and its continuation. Most of their concerns were things that took place outside of the venue. Gulf Shores High School teacher Dr. Susan Nelson spoke in favor of the festival highlighting several positive opportunities allowed to their students through the festival operation. Michelle Stancil, another local resident, spoke in favor of the festival and the opportunities she and her teenage son had enjoyed through the years. Shaul Zislin, representing the Hangout Music Festival, thanked the Mayor and Council for allowing the festival and gave a brief summary of the economic impact it has on the city. Mayor Robert Craft stated he appreciated everyone’s input.

There being no further business to come before the Council, Councilman Stephen E. Jones moved to adjourn; seconded by Councilman Joe Garris, Jr.; and the vote of those officials present was unanimously in favor of the motion.
