**MINUTES OF  
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING  
CITY OF GULF SHORES, ALABAMA  
JULY 27, 2020**

Mayor Robert Craft called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. at the Erie Hall Meyer Civic Center. Mayor Craft noted that the location of the meeting had been moved to the Erie Hall Meyer Civic Center in order to provide enough space to maintain social distancing for everyone in attendance. The meeting was streamed via Facebook Live at <https://www.facebook.com/cityofgulfshoresal>.

The invocation was delivered by Councilman Stephen E. Jones.

Upon roll call, the following officials answered "present": Councilman Joe Garris, Jr., Councilman Gary M. Sinak, Councilman Philip Harris, Councilman Jason Dyken, M.D., Councilman Stephen E. Jones and Mayor Robert Craft.

Councilman Joe Garris, Jr. moved to approve the minutes of the Regular Council Meeting of July 13, 2020, as presented; seconded by Councilman Gary M. Sinak; was discussed and considered in full by the Council; and upon the question, the vote thereon was as follows: Councilman Joe Garris, Jr., "aye"; Councilman Gary Sinak, "aye"; Councilman Philip Harris, "aye"; Councilman Jason Dyken, M.D., "aye"; Councilman Stephen E. Jones, "aye" and Mayor Robert Craft, "aye". Whereupon, Mayor Robert Craft declared the motion carried.

At this time, Councilman Philip Harris moved to approve the minutes of the Council Work Session Meeting of July 20, 2020, as presented; seconded by Councilman Stephen E. Jones; was discussed and considered in full by the Council; and upon the question, the vote thereon was as follows: Councilman Joe Garris, Jr., "aye"; Councilman Gary Sinak, "aye"; Councilman Philip Harris, "aye"; Councilman Jason Dyken, M.D., "aye"; Councilman Stephen E. Jones, "aye" and Mayor Robert Craft, "aye". Whereupon, Mayor Robert Craft declared the motion carried.

Furthermore, Councilman Gary M. Sinak moved to approve the minutes of the Special Meeting of July 20, 2020, as presented; seconded by Councilman Joe Garris, Jr.; was discussed and considered in full by the Council; and upon the question, the vote thereon was as follows: Councilman Joe Garris, Jr., "aye"; Councilman Gary Sinak, "aye"; Councilman Philip Harris, "aye"; Councilman Jason Dyken, M.D., "aye"; Councilman Stephen E. Jones, "aye" and Mayor Robert Craft, "aye". Whereupon, Mayor Robert Craft declared the motion carried.

Councilman Jason Dyken, M.D. moved to approve the expense vouchers in the amount of \$1,989,280.04 seconded by Councilman Stephen E. Jones; and the vote of those officials present was unanimously in favor of the motion.

The City Clerk noted that the complete list of vouchers to be paid, as reflected on a computer printout, had been made a permanent record in the Clerk's office.

At this time, Chief Poll Inspector Evelyn Sanders gave a brief presentation of the duties of election officials stating every poll worker has to go through training and be certified. City Clerk Wanda Parris gave a brief summary on absentee voting for the upcoming municipal election.

Gulf Shores City Schools Superintendent Dr. Matt Akin along with Assistant Superintendent Dr. Stephanie Harrison gave a brief Instructional State of the Schools presentation which covered the accomplishments over the last school year and what to expect the next school year. They both excitedly announced the many new programs that would be coming to the schools this fall to include a Spanish Teacher at the elementary and middle school, the starting of the Applied Design Academy and the addition of steel drums to the music department just to name a few.

Furthermore, Councilman Stephen E. Jones moved for unanimous consent of the Council to suspend the rules of procedure to allow for the immediate consideration of the following Ordinance:

**ORDINANCE NO. 1984**

**AN ORDINANCE  
TO AMEND THE CODE OF ORDINANCES,  
ADOPTED JULY 24, 1989,  
AT CHAPTER 21, TRAFFIC, ARTICLE I., IN GENERAL,  
BY ADDING CERTAIN LANGUAGE  
AT SECTION 21-4, TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNS AND DEVICES**

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BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GULF SHORES, ALABAMA, WHILE IN REGULAR SESSION ON JULY 27, 2020, as follows:

**Section 1.** That Chapter 21, TRAFFIC, of the Code of Ordinances, adopted July 24, 1989, be and it is hereby amended by adding certain language at Article I., In General, Section 21-4, Traffic Control Signs and Devices by amending the Vulcan Traffic Management Services Plan to include the installation of Three-Way Stop traffic control signage at the intersection of West 2<sup>nd</sup> Street and West Commerce Avenue and Wedgewood Drive and West Fairway Drive; and installation of Four-Way Stop traffic control signage at the intersection of West 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue and West 3<sup>rd</sup> Street; so the entire section shall read:

CHAPTER 21 TRAFFIC

ARTICLE I. IN GENERAL

\* \* \*

Sec. 21-4. Traffic Control Signs and Devices.

\* \* \*

Add three-way stop traffic control signs at the intersection of West 2<sup>nd</sup> Street and West Commerce Ave and also at intersection of Wedgewood Drive and West Fairway Drive.

\* \* \*

**Section 2.** The intersection of West 2<sup>nd</sup> Street/West Commerce Ave and Wedgewood Drive/West Fairway Drive is hereby declared henceforth to be a three-way stop intersection.

\* \* \*

Sec. 21-7. Traffic Control Signs and Devices.

\* \* \*

Add four-way stop traffic control signs at the intersection of West 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue and West 3<sup>rd</sup> Street.

\* \* \*

**Section 3.** The intersection of West 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue and West 3<sup>rd</sup> Street is hereby declared henceforth to be a four-way stop intersection.

\* \* \*

**Section 4.** That this Ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption and publication as required by law.

The motion for unanimous consent was seconded by Councilman Joe Garris, Jr.; and upon the question, the vote thereon was as follows: Councilman Joe Garris, Jr., “aye”; Councilman Gary M. **A RESOLUTION  
DECLARING PHILIP HARRIS  
DULY ELECTED TO OFFICE OF  
CITY COUNCIL, PLACE 3**

WHEREAS, Sections 11-46-20 through 11-46-73 of the *Alabama Code of 1975*, as amended, provide for and regulate general and special elections in cities and towns of this state, except those cities and towns which have a commission form of government; and,

WHEREAS, Section 11-46-43 of the *Alabama Code of 1975* prohibits write-in candidates in elections held under Sections 11-46-20 through 11-46-73 of the *Alabama Code of 1975*, as amended; and,

WHEREAS, Section 11-46-26 of the *Alabama Code of 1975*, as amended, provides that if only one person has filed a statement of candidacy or has been nominated for an office for an election to be held pursuant to Sections 11-46-20 through 11-46-73 of the *Alabama Code of 1975*, as amended, at the time the deadline for qualification has passed, then such person, shall for all purposes, be deemed elected to such office, and the mayor or other chief executive officer shall not cause the name of such person or the office for which his candidacy was declared to be printed on the ballot, but he shall immediately file a written statement with the governing body of the municipality, attested by the clerk, certifying the fact that only one person filed a statement of candidacy or was nominated for the office preceding the deadline set for an election of municipal officers of the municipality and setting forth the name of such person; and,

WHEREAS, said Section 11-46-26, as amended, provides that the governing body of the municipality, after receiving such statement, shall adopt a Resolution declaring the person named in the statement duly elected to the office described in the statement, and shall issue a Certificate of Election to such person; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Gulf Shores has filed a written statement with the governing body of the municipality, attested by the Clerk, certifying the fact that only one person filed a statement of candidacy for the office of City Council, Place 3, prior to the deadline and that the name of that person who filed such statement was Philip Harris.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GULF SHORES, ALABAMA, WHILE IN REGULAR SESSION ON JULY 27, 2020, as follows:

**Section 1.** That Philip Harris be and he is hereby declared duly elected to the office of City Council, Place 3, in the City of Gulf Shores for the term of office commencing on the first Monday in November, 2020.

**Section 2.** That it further be resolved that the Mayor of the City of Gulf Shores be and he hereby is directed to issue a certificate of election to Philip Harris for the office of City Council, Place 3, for such term pursuant to the provisions of Section 11-46-25, as amended.

**Section 3.** That this Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.

**Section 1.** That the Mayor and City Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and directed to execute and attest, respectively, a Tri-Party Agreement between the City of Gulf Shores, the Gulf Shores & Orange Beach Sports Commission and the Alabama Independent School Association in substantially the form presented to Council this date.

**Section 2.** In exchange, the Gulf Shores & Orange Beach Sports Commission shall provide to the City an event to promote tourism and entertainment to be known as the AISA State Track Championship to be held in Gulf Shores, Alabama in the Spring of 2021 and 2022 as agreed upon by both parties; and

**Section 3.** That this Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.

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WHEREAS, the City and the Gulf Shores City Board of Education are continuing to make preparations in the anticipation of the 2020-2021 school year. Some of the primary areas of focus include making improvements to the Gulf Shores High School gym and locker rooms which have not been expanded since they were originally built by Baldwin County Schools in 1998.

WHEREAS, the City School Board eased immediate overcrowding concerns at Gulf Shores Elementary prior to the 2019-20 school year by shifting 6<sup>th</sup> grade to Gulf Shores Middle. However, continued enrollment growth and the addition of new pre-K classes at GSES necessitate the construction of additional classroom capacity.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GULF SHORES, ALABAMA, WHILE IN REGULAR SESSION ON JULY 27, 2020, as follows:

**Section 1.** That the proposal from Walcott Adams Verneuille and Goodwyn Mills and Cawood architectural firms for professional services in an amount not to exceed \$313,530.00 be and the same is hereby accepted, authorized and outlined in the Scope of Work and/or as specified for additional services.

**Section 2.** That the Mayor and City Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and directed to execute and attest, respectively, a professional services agreement between the City of Gulf Shores and Walcott Adams Verneuille and Goodwyn Mills and Cawood architectural firms in substantially the form presented to Council this date.

**Section 3.** The Council will need to formally amend its 2020 Budget to provide an estimated \$3.3 million dollars for architectural services, as well as construction contracts for these Phase 3 improvements from the City’s \$17 million series 2020 –B GO Warrant’s proceeds. You should also be advised that the School Superintendent has estimated that an additional \$2.4 million is anticipated to be received by years end from the recently passed State School Bond for school construction projects.

**Section 4.** That this Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.
