MINUTES
RESCHEDULED COUNCIL WORK SESSION
CITY OF GULF SHORES, ALABAMA
AUGUST 2, 2021

The City Council of the City of Gulf Shores, Alabama met in a regular Council Work Session Meeting on Monday, August 2, 2021 at 4:00 p.m. with Mayor Pro Tempore Philip Harris presiding. The meeting was held at City Hall and was streamed via Facebook Live.

Upon roll call, the following members answered present: Councilman Jason Dyken, M.D. and Mayor Pro Tempore Philip Harris. Councilman Joe Garris, Jr., Councilman Gary M. Sinak, Councilman Stephen E. Jones and Mayor Robert Craft were absent.

1. Councilman Discussion Period – Mayor Pro Tempore Philip Harris
Mayor Pro Tempore Harris called upon City Administrator Steve Griffin to give an update on the status of the hearing for the revocation of the business license of the Gulf Shores Landfill.

Mr. Griffin announced that after some negotiation, the City had agreed to reschedule the hearing until Monday, August 16th, 2021 at 4:30 p.m.

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9. Mayor Pro Tempore opened the floor for anyone that was unable to get on the printed agenda to speak.
 - a) Gulf Shores City School Board of Education Chairman, Kevin Corcoran, announced that the Back to School Guide had been published and would be discussed at the Board of Education Work Session Meeting on Thursday, August 5th at 4:00 p.m.


b) Mr. Corcoran also conveyed his support for Mayor Craft's statement dated July 30, 2021 stating that the time for negotiations between ALDOT and the Beach Express Toll Bridge owners has passed. A 90 day project delay is unacceptable. It is time for ALDOT to build the new bridge.

10. Several citizens from the Meyer Park and Wedgewood area spoke regarding drainage and flooding issues caused by blocked culvert pipes.


Mayor Pro Tempore Harris assured everyone that the City was aware of the issue and is committed to a program of cleaning, clearing, and maintaining all these areas. Additional resources (equipment and personnel) are being deployed to resolve the problem. Mark Acreman, City Engineer, will discuss specifics with citizens following the meeting.

Meyer Park area residents would also like to see something done about vehicles speeding in that vicinity and illegal short term rental of residential houses in the neighborhood.
