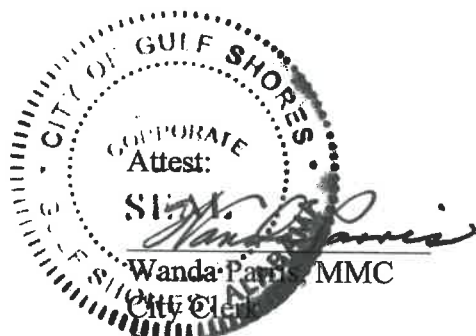


MINUTES
