**MINUTES OF  
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING  
CITY OF GULF SHORES, ALABAMA  
SEPTEMBER 23, 2019**

Mayor Robert Craft called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. at City Hall. The invocation was delivered by Councilman Stephen E. Jones.

Upon roll call, the following officials answered "present": Councilman Gary M. Sinak, Councilman Philip Harris, Councilman Jason Dyken, M.D., Councilman Stephen E. Jones and Mayor Robert Craft. Councilman Joe Garris Jr. was absent.

Councilman Jason Dyken, M.D. moved to approve the minutes of the Regular Council Meeting of September 9, 2019, as presented; seconded by Councilman Stephen E. Jones; was discussed and considered in full by the Council; and upon the question, the vote thereon was as follows: Councilman Gary M. Sinak, "aye", Councilman Philip Harris, "aye", Councilman Jason Dyken, M.D., "aye", Councilman Stephen E. Jones, "aye" and Mayor Robert Craft "aye". Councilman Joe Garris, Jr. was absent. Whereupon, Mayor Robert Craft declared the motion carried.

Furthermore, Councilman Gary M. Sinak moved to approve the minutes of the Council Work Session Meeting of September 16, 2019, as presented; seconded by Councilman Philip Harris; was discussed and considered in full by the Council; and upon the question, the vote thereon was as follows: Councilman Gary M. Sinak, "aye", Councilman Philip Harris, "aye", Councilman Jason Dyken, M.D., "abstain", Councilman Stephen E. Jones, "aye" and Mayor Robert Craft "aye". Councilman Joe Garris, Jr. was absent. Whereupon, Mayor Robert Craft declared the motion carried.

Councilman Philip Harris moved to approve the minutes of the Special Meeting of September 16, 2019, as presented; seconded by Councilman Gary M. Sinak; as discussed and considered in full by the Council; and upon the question, the vote thereon was as follows: Councilman Gary M. Sinak, "aye", Councilman Philip Harris, "aye", Councilman Jason Dyken, M.D., "abstain", Councilman Stephen E. Jones, "aye" and Mayor Robert Craft "aye". Councilman Joe Garris, Jr. was absent. Whereupon, Mayor Robert Craft declared the motion carried.

Councilman Philip Harris moved to approve the expense vouchers in the amount of \$630,582.22 seconded by Councilman Stephen E. Jones; and the vote of those officials present was unanimously in favor of the motion.

The City Clerk noted that the complete list of vouchers to be paid, as reflected on a computer printout, had been made a permanent record in the Clerk's office.

At this time, Melissa Byrd founder of Jensen's Heart of Gold, presented the Mayor and Council with a plaque in appreciation of their support of the Super Slugger Softball Tournament she founded in memory of her son Jensen Byrd who passed away from child hood cancer. This is the tournaments 9<sup>th</sup> year with this being the largest event yet, 55 teams participated which raised \$40,000.00.

Director of Recreation and Cultural Affairs, Grant Brown introduced a Public Assembly Permit Application from the Gulf Shores Police Department to host National Night Out 2019 to be held on October 1, 2019 at Pelican Place.

Following a brief discussion, Councilman Philip Harris moved to approve the Assembly Permit Application from the Gulf Shores Police Department to host National Night Out to be held on October 1, 2019 at Pelican Place as presented; seconded by Councilman Gary M. Sinak; and the vote thereon was as follows: Councilman Gary M. Sinak, "aye", Councilman Philip Harris, "aye", Councilman Jason Dyken, M.D., "aye", Councilman Stephen E. Jones, "aye", and Mayor Robert Craft, "aye". Councilman Joe Garris, Jr. was absent. Whereupon, Mayor Robert Craft declared the motion carried.

At this time, Councilman Gary M. Sinak introduced and moved for the adoption of the following Resolution:

**RESOLUTION NO. 6189-19**

**A RESOLUTION  
AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE  
MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE AND ATTEST, RESPECTIVELY,  
AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN AIRMEDCARE NETWORK  
AND THE CITY OF GULF SHORES TO PROVIDE GROUND AMBULANCE  
AND AIR EMERGENCY TRANSPORT TO  
CITIZENS WHO LIVE WITHIN CORPORATE LIMITS OF GULF SHORES  
IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$163,798.40**

WHEREAS, the City of Gulf Shores' Vision 2025 Key Strategy to provide leading edge healthcare for our citizens was the starting point of this project. Identifying ways to improve the health, safety, and general wellbeing of our residents is paramount; and

WHEREAS, one issue identified by staff is the high cost of non-covered emergency transport service via ambulance and helicopter. Gulf Shores residents have experienced exorbitant out of pocket medical bills for air and ground ambulance even after co-pays; and

WHEREAS, Medstar Emergency Medical Service is the exclusive ground ambulance provider in Baldwin County, who also operates two medical helicopters. Together we have found a solution that we feel will greatly benefit the citizens of Gulf Shores who live within the corporate limits.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GULF SHORES, ALABAMA, WHILE IN REGULAR SESSION ON SEPTEMBER 23, 2019, as follows:

**Section 1.** That the Mayor and City Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and directed to execute and attest, respectively, an agreement between the City of Gulf Shores and AirMedCare Network to provide Ground Ambulance and Air Emergency Transport Service to the residents of Gulf Shores in an amount not to exceed \$163,798.40; in substantially the form presented to Council this date.

**Section 2.** This agreement will be for 1 (one) year, commencing on October 1, 2019; and

**Section 3.** This non-budgeted annual expense of \$163,798.40 is proposed to be amended into the 2019 General Fund Budget.

**Section 4.** That this Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.

Jones; was regularly put; was discussed and considered in full by the Council; and upon the question, the vote thereon was as follows: Councilman Gary M. WHEREAS, Section 12-14-13, *Code of Alabama 1975*, provides that the municipal court shall hold court only at the times and place provided by the municipal governing body; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined the place, dates, and times at which Court shall be held, as set forth below;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GULF SHORES, ALABAMA, WHILE IN REGULAR SESSION ON SEPTEMBER 23, 2019, as follows:

**Section 1.** That the place for holding open court by the Municipal Court of the City of Gulf Shores, Alabama, during the year 2020 shall be in the Municipal Court Building, 203 Clubhouse Drive, Suite A, Gulf Shores, Alabama.

**Section 2.** That the time for holding Plea Docket Court (the first court date of each month) shall be at 2:00 p.m. The time for holding Trial Docket Court (the second court date of each month) shall be at 2:00 p.m.

**Section 3.** That the dates for holding open court by the Municipal Court of the City of Gulf Shores, Alabama, are hereby established for the year 2020 as being:

**A RESOLUTION  
APPROVING, CONFIRMING AND RATIFYING  
THE AIRPORT AUTHORITY'S EXECUTION OF A  
LICENSE AND OPERATING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE  
AIRPORT AUTHORITY AND SKYWARRIORS FLIGHT TRAINING, INC.  
TO PROVIDE FLIGHT INSTRUCTION**

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WHEREAS, Skywarriors Flight Training, Inc. proposes to sublease facilities from Gulf Air Center, Inc. to provide flight instruction for the Navy Initial Flight School Program.

WHEREAS, revenue associated with this permit will be 2% of gross revenues from services provided at or on the airport with a minimum guarantee of \$100 per month.

WHEREAS, to encourage economic development and support for new commercial airport business, the Airport Authority of the City of Gulf Shores adopted Resolution No.751-19 approving a one year license term with the option to renew on a year to year basis.

WHEREAS, in compliance with the executed 2008 amended and restated Lease, Assignment, and Operating Agreement between the City and the Authority, Council authorization, ratification and confirmation is requested as follows:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GULF SHORES, ALABAMA, WHILE IN REGULAR SESSION ON SEPTEMBER 23, 2019, as follows:

**Section 1.** The Authority did, at its Board Meeting of July 22, 2019 approve the issuance of a License and Operating Agreement for Skywarriors Flight Training, Inc. and authorized execution of such license and operating agreement for a one year term with the option to renew on a year to year basis; and

**Section 2.** In accordance with paragraph 1.10 of the Amended and Restated Airport Lease Agreement between the Authority and the City, the Authority has requested approval by the City Council of such action; and

**Section 3.** That the action of the Authority approving the issuance of a License and Operating Agreement between the Authority and Skywarrior Flight Training, Inc. to sublease facilities from Gulf Air Center, Inc. located at the Jack Edwards National Airport on land owned by the City and leased to the Authority, be and it is hereby confirmed, ratified and approved as presented.

**Section 4.** That this Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.

The motion for the adoption of Resolution No. 6191-19 seconded by Councilman Gary M. Sinak; was regularly put; was discussed and considered in full by the Council; and upon the question, the vote thereon was as follows: Councilman Gary M. Sinak, "aye", Councilman Philip Harris, "aye", Councilman Jason Dyken, M.D., "aye", Councilman Stephen E. Jones, "aye", and Mayor Robert Craft, "aye". Councilman Joe Garris, Jr. was absent. Mayor Robert Craft declared Resolution No. 6191-19 duly and legally adopted.

Councilman Stephen E. Jones moved for unanimous consent of the Council to suspend the rules of procedure to allow for the immediate consideration of the following Ordinance:

**ORDINANCE NO. 1953**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE *CODE OF ORDINANCES*,  
ADOPTED JULY 24, 1989, AT CHAPTER 6, BEACHES, BOATS, AND WATERWAYS,  
ARTICLE I. IN GENERAL BY ADDITION OF SECTION 6-19 TO PROHIBIT THE LANDING  
OF ANY SEAPLANE ON THE WATERS OF LITTLE LAGOON OR THE INTRACOASTAL  
WATERWAY AND TO PRESCRIBE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS**

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WHEREAS, The City of Gulf Shores is a Class 8 Alabama Municipality which has been vested with a portion of the state's sovereign power to protect the public health, safety and general welfare. *Code of Alabama, 1975, §11-45-1*; and

WHEREAS, Gulf Shores is a unique, coastal-resort location that attracts millions of visitors each year. The City Council finds that the landing of seaplanes on the waters of Little Lagoon or the Intracoastal Waterway within the corporate limits and police jurisdiction of the City of Gulf Shores will compromise the public health, safety, and general welfare of its citizens and visitors by creating noise, danger, apprehension of danger, pollution, apprehension of pollution, contamination and infestation from other bodies of water, destruction of property values, and interference with other lawful uses of Little Lagoon and the Intracoastal Waterway enjoyed by the public, including boating, sailing, fishing, swimming and other recreational uses; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Gulf Shores Council finds that in order to protect the public health, safety and general welfare it is necessary to prohibit the landing of seaplanes on the waters of Little Lagoon and Intracoastal Waterway within the corporate limits and police jurisdiction of the City of Gulf Shores,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GULF SHORES, ALABAMA, WHILE IN REGULAR SESSION ON SEPTEMBER 23, 2019, as follows:

**Section 1.** That Article I of Chapter 6, Beaches, Boats, and Waterways of the *Code of Ordinances*, adopted July 24, 1989, be and it is hereby amended by the addition of Section 6-19 to read in its entirety as follows:

“Sec. 6-19 -- LANDING OF SEAPLANES ON THE WATERS OF LITTLE LAGOON AND INTRACOASTAL WATERWAY PROHIBITED.

(a) Definitions. As used in this section, the following terms have the indicated meanings:

*Seaplane* includes flying boat, hull seaplane, floatplane, and float equipped helicopter.

*Little Lagoon* means any portion of Little Lagoon lying within the corporate limits or police jurisdiction of the City of Gulf Shores.

*Intracoastal Waterway* means any portion of the Intracoastal Waterway lying within the corporate limits or police jurisdiction of the City of Gulf Shores between Bon Secour Bay on the west and the corporate limits of the City of Orange Beach on the east.

(b) It shall be unlawful and a public nuisance for any person to land a seaplane on the waters of Little Lagoon or the Intracoastal Waterway. This section shall not apply (1) to officers and agents of the United States, the state, the county, or the city when acting in the line and scope of their duty in the implementation or enforcement of federal, state, or local laws or in the provision of emergency services during the period of any state of emergency declared by the Governor of the State of Alabama or (2) to any person who lands after declaring an inflight emergency requiring immediate action in accordance with FAR §91.3.

(c) Any person violating this section shall be guilty of an offense and upon conviction, shall be punished for each offense by a fine of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00), imprisonment for a period not exceeding six (6) months, or both.

**Section 2.** That this Ordinance shall not be interpreted to repeal any other ordinance of the City of Gulf Shores or any provision of the law of Alabama adopted by operation of Section 1-8 of the City's Code of Ordinances.

**Section 3.** That the provisions of this Ordinance are severable and a determination of the invalidity of any portion of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity and enforceability of the remainder of the Ordinance.

**Section 4.** That this Ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption and publication as required by law.

The motion for unanimous consent was seconded by Councilman Jason Dyken, M.D.; and upon the question, the vote thereon was as follows: Councilman Gary M. Sinak, "aye", Councilman Philip Harris, "aye", Councilman Jason Dyken, M.D., "aye", Councilman Stephen E. Jones, "aye" and Mayor Robert Craft, "aye". Councilman Joe Garris, Jr. was absent. Mayor Robert Craft declared the rules suspended.

Furthermore, Councilman Jason Dyken, M.D. then moved for the adoption of Ordinance No. 1953 and to waive the reading of said Ordinance at length. The motion for the adoption of Ordinance No. 1953 was seconded by Councilman Gary M. Sinak; was discussed and considered in full by the Council; and upon the question, the vote thereon was as follows: Councilman Gary M. Sinak, "aye", Councilman Philip Harris, "aye", Councilman Jason Dyken, M.D., "aye", Councilman Stephen E. Jones, "aye", and Mayor Robert Craft, "aye". Councilman Joe Garris, Jr. was absent. Mayor Robert Craft declared Ordinance No. 1953 duly and legally adopted.

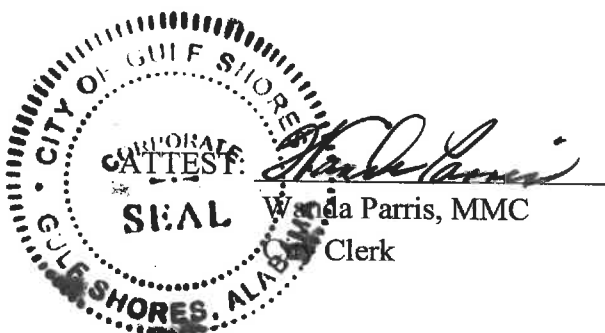
City School Superintendent Dr. Matt Akin gave an update concerning after school care stating they would now be able to extend care to all the kids who had been on the waiting list.
