REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
CITY OF GULF SHORES, ALABAMA
OCTOBER 24, 2022**

Mayor Robert Craft called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. at the Gulf Shores City Hall Council Chambers.

The invocation was delivered by Councilman Stephen E. Jones.

Upon roll call, the following officials answered "present": Councilman Joe Garris, Jr., Councilman Gary M. Sinak, Councilman Philip Harris, Councilman Jason Dyken, M.D., Councilman Stephen E. Jones and Mayor Robert Craft.

Councilman Joe Garris, Jr. moved to approve the minutes of the Special Meeting of October 10, 2022, as presented; seconded by Councilman Gary M. Sinak; was discussed and considered in full by the Council; and upon the question, the vote thereon was as follows: Councilman Joe Garris, Jr., "aye", Councilman Gary M. Sinak, "aye", Councilman Philip Harris, "aye", Councilman Jason Dyken, M.D., "aye", Councilman Stephen E. Jones, "aye", and Mayor Robert Craft, "abstain". Whereupon, Mayor Robert Craft declared the motion carried.

At this time, Councilman Philip Harris moved to approve the minutes of the Regular Council Meeting Session Meeting of October 10, 2022, as presented; seconded by Councilman Jason Dyken, M.D.; was discussed and considered in full by the Council; and upon the question, the vote thereon was as follows: Councilman Joe Garris, Jr., "aye", Councilman Gary M. Sinak, "aye", Councilman Philip Harris, "aye", Councilman Jason Dyken, M.D. "aye", Councilman Stephen E. Jones, "aye", and Mayor Robert Craft, "abstain". Whereupon, Mayor Robert Craft declared the motion carried.

Furthermore, Councilman Gary M. Sinak moved to approve the minutes of the Council Work Session Meeting of October 17, 2022, as presented; seconded by Councilman Joe Garris, Jr.; was discussed and considered in full by the Council; and upon the question, the vote thereon was as follows: Councilman Joe Garris, Jr., "aye", Councilman Gary M. Sinak, "aye", Councilman Philip Harris, "aye", Councilman Jason Dyken, M.D. "aye", Councilman Stephen E. Jones, "aye", and Mayor Robert Craft, "aye". Whereupon, Mayor Robert Craft declared the motion carried.

Councilman Stephen E. Jones moved to approve the expense vouchers in the amount of \$848,583.19 seconded by Councilman Philip Harris; and the vote of those officials present was unanimously in favor of the motion.

The City Clerk noted that the complete list of vouchers to be paid, as reflected on a computer printout, had been made a permanent record in the Clerk's office.

At this time, Gulf Shores Police Chief Ed Delmore announced the promotion of Nate Harris from Sergeant to Lieutenant and read a brief bio of his law enforcement career. Mayor Robert Craft administered the Oath of Office swearing him in as Lieutenant.

Director of Recreation and Cultural Affairs Grant Brown introduced and recommended approval of a Public Assembly Permit Application from the City of Gulf Shores to host the 2023 Winter Series. The 2023 Winter Series consists of 4 shows starting at the end of January and ending the first week of March. The last two shows of the series will also feature food trucks and beverage sales.

Councilman Philip Harris moved to approve the Assembly Permit Application from the City of Gulf Shores to host the 2023 Winter Series to be held starting at the end of January and ending the first week of March, 2023 as presented; seconded by Councilman Gary M. Sinak; and the vote thereon was as follows: Councilman Joe Garris, Jr., “aye”, Councilman Gary M. Sinak, “aye”, Councilman Philip Harris, “aye”, Councilman Jason Dyken, M.D., “aye”, Councilman Stephen E. Jones, “abstain”, and Mayor Robert Craft, “aye”. Whereupon, Mayor Robert Craft Harris declared the motion carried.

At this time, Councilman Jason Dyken moved for the adoption of the following Resolution:

**A RESOLUTION
AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A
PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT BETWEEN
THE CITY OF GULF SHORES AND DIX.HITE + PARTNERS
FOR MASTER PLANNING & DESIGN SERVICES RELATED TO
COASTAL GATEWAY COMMUNITY PARK PROJECT
IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,768,200.00**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GULF SHORES, ALABAMA, WHILE IN REGULAR SESSION ON OCTOBER 24, 2022, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor and City Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and directed to execute and attest, respectively, a professional services contract between the City of Gulf Shores and Dix.Hite + Partners to provide master planning consultation services, landscape design, architectural, engineering, and program management services for the 127-acre Coastal Gateway Community Park and the North/South Connector Road in an amount not to exceed \$1,768,200.00; in substantially the form presented to Council this date.

Section 2. That the amount not to exceed will be divided into task amounts to include:

Task 1 – Master Plan Dream/Discover/Design	\$175,000 Lump sum
Task 2 – Phase 1 Design/Document	\$1,075,000 Lump sum
Task 3 – North/South Connector Road	\$518,200 Lump sum

Design/Document

Section 3. That \$300,000 has been budgeted in 2022 in the Recreation Parks Fund #40-555-80874 for the Community Park Development, and an additional \$10,600,000 has been budgeted in out-years of 2023-2025 for a total budget of \$10,900,000. \$6,900,000 has separately been budgeted for the construction of the North/South Connector Road in Fund #42-879-80911 to be built concurrently with the park.

Section 4. That this Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.

ORDINANCE NO. 2074

**AN ORDINANCE
ASSENTING TO THE ANNEXATION
OF CERTAIN PROPERTY DESCRIBED HEREIN TO
THE CITY OF GULF SHORES, ALABAMA AND
EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY
TO INCLUDE SUCH PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, on the 27th of September, 2022 Ms. Alicia S. King, owner of all the real property hereinafter described, did file with the City Clerk a petition asking that the said tracts or parcels of land be annexed to and become a part of the City of Gulf Shores; and

WHEREAS, said petition did contain the signatures of all of the owners of the described territory and a map of said property showing its relationship to the corporate limits of the City of Gulf Shores; and

WHEREAS, the governing body did determine that it is in the public interest that said property be annexed to the City of Gulf Shores and it did further determine that all legal requirements for annexing said real property have been met pursuant to Sections 11-42-20 through 11-42-24, Code of Alabama, 1975;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GULF SHORES, ALABAMA, WHILE IN REGULAR SESSION ON OCTOBER 24, 2022 as follows:

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Gulf Shores, Alabama, finds and declares that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City, and the citizens of the affected area, to bring the territory described in Section 2 of this ordinance into the City of Gulf Shores.

Section 2. That the boundary lines of the City of Gulf Shores, Alabama, be and the same are hereby altered or rearranged so as to include all of the territory hereto before encompassed by the corporate limits of the City of Gulf Shores, Alabama, and in addition thereto the following described territory, to-wit:

As situated in Baldwin County, Alabama, to-wit:

Lot 6, Oak River View Subdivision
6981 Grund Lane
Gulf Shores, AL 36542

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be published as provided by law, and a certified copy of same, together with a certified copy of the petition of the property owners, shall be filed with the Probate Judge of Baldwin County, Alabama.

Section 4. That the territory described in this ordinance shall become a part of the corporate limits of the City of Gulf Shores, Alabama, upon publication of this ordinance as set forth in Section 3 above.

Section 5. That this Ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption and publication as required by law.

The motion for unanimous consent was seconded by Councilman Joe Garris, Jr.; and upon the question, the vote thereon was as follows: Councilman Joe Garris, Jr., “aye” Councilman Gary M. Department Heads presented City project updates.


At this time, Mayor Robert Craft invited anyone that was not listed on the printed agenda and wanted to address the Council to come forward.
