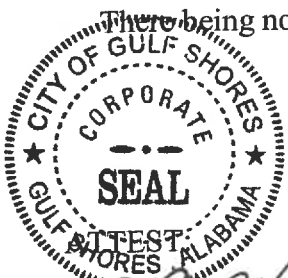
MINUTES



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Several neighbors spoke in opposition to approval for short term rental and added concerns for adequate available parking.
