



Beautification Award Criteria

Judging for the Commercial or Residential Award is based on overall appearance from the street, creative use of decorations, lighting, inflatable figures, and effective use of area.

- Overall curb appearance of the property and compatibility with the appearance of the surrounding areas. The property must be visible from the street.
- Design: Selection, grouping, placement and variety of plant material, originality of design, and classic to area.
- Judging includes plant materials, design, architecture, and inclusion of environmentally sustainable practice and maintenance.

CATAGORIES

Residential

Commercial

Seasonal/Holiday – Christmas, Mardi Gras, Easter, Memorial Day, Fourth of July, Halloween, or other as deemed appropriate by the Beautification Award Committee.

Properties may not be in gated communities.

Properties may be designed and/or implemented by the homeowner, renter, or Landscape Company.

Each property is limited to winning the award only once within one calendar year. (January 1 – December 31)

Members of the Beautification Board are not eligible to receive the award.

A **Note of Recognition** may be sent to a property owner, as encouragement of their property deemed worthy of recognition.
