City of Gulf Shores Announces Martin Luther King Jr. Holiday Closures

Gulf Shores, Ala. – In honor of Martin Luther King Jr. Day, the City of Gulf Shores will have the following facility closures and changes to regular hours of operations:

- Administrative offices for the City of Gulf Shores will be closed on Monday, January 17. Police, fire, and other emergency services will remain open to ensure public safety and health. Regular operations will resume on Tuesday, January 18, at 8 a.m.
- The City Store will be closed Monday, January 17, and will resume regular operations on Tuesday, January 18.
- The Thomas B. Norton Public Library and the Gulf Shores Museum will be closed Monday, January 17. Regular operation hours for the library and museum will resume on Tuesday, January 18.
- The Bodenhamer Recreation Center will remain open on Monday, January 17.
- Studio Fitness at the Gulf Shores Cultural Center will be closed on Monday, January 17. Regular operation hours will resume on Tuesday, January 18.
- The George C. Meyer Tennis Center will be closed on Monday, January 17. Regular operation hours will resume on Tuesday, January 18. Tennis courts will remain open and available for play.
- Republic Services Garbage and Recycling Services will run as scheduled. Yard debris/bulky pickup will run as scheduled.
- The City Council Work Session (Committee of the Whole) meeting has been rescheduled for Tuesday, January 18, at 4 p.m. in the City Hall Council Chambers.
