## City of Gulf Shores Announces Closures for Mardi Gras

**Gulf Shores, Ala.** – In observance of the Mardi Gras holiday, the City of Gulf Shores will have the following facility closures and changes to regular hours of operations:

- Police, fire, and other emergency services will remain open to ensure public safety and health.
- Administrative offices for the City of Gulf Shores will be closed on Tuesday, March 1. Regular operations will resume on Wednesday, March 2, at 8 a.m.
- The Thomas B. Norton Public Library and the Gulf Shores Museum will be closed Tuesday, March 1. Regular operation hours for both facilities will resume on Wednesday, March 2.
- The City Store will be closed on Tuesday, March 1. Regular operation hours will resume on Wednesday, March 2.
- The Bodenhamer Recreation Center will be open from 5:30 a.m. to 8 p.m. on Tuesday, March 1. The Cultural Center will be closed Tuesday, March 1. Regular operation hours for the Cultural Center will resume on Wednesday, March 2.
- The George C. Meyer Tennis Center will be closed Tuesday, March 1. Courts will be open and available for public use. Regular operation hours will resume on Wednesday, March 2.
- Republic Services Garbage and Recycling Service will run as scheduled.
- Yard debris/bulky pickup will not run on Tuesday, March 1. Routes scheduled for Tuesday, March 1, will run on Monday, February 28.
