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City of Gulf Shores to Hold Public Meeting to Discuss the West Fourth Street Bridge and Pedestrian Safety Improvements along Windmill Ridge Road

Gulf Shores, Ala. – The City of Gulf Shores will host a public information meeting on July 20 to discuss proposed solutions for the West Fourth Street bridge and recommended pedestrian safety improvements along Windmill Ridge Road and surrounding areas.

Due to deteriorating conditions and public safety concerns, the bridge on West Fourth Street is closed to vehicular traffic. In 2021 the City partnered with Skipper Consulting, a transportation engineering firm, to complete a traffic study that evaluated the feasibility of constructing a new bridge on West Fourth Street and reopening it to vehicular, bicycle and pedestrian traffic. City Staff will present the findings of this study and recommendations provided by Skipper Consulting at the public information meeting.

The meeting will occur on Wednesday, July 20, at 5:30 p.m. in the Gulf Shores City Council Chambers, located at 1905 West 1st Street. After the presentation, attendees can ask questions and provide feedback on the project to City staff members.
