

Right-of-Way Improvement Permit

A Right-of-Way Improvement Permit is required for any construction, improvement, or maintenance activities within streets, alleys, or other public or private rights-of-way. This permit ensures all work complies with the City of Gulf Shores Zoning Ordinance, Subdivision Regulations, and Right-of-Way Design Standards.

How to Apply

Applications must be submitted online through the [City of Gulf Shores Online Licensing and Permitting Portal](#). The portal provides a step-by-step guide to assist applicants throughout the permitting process.

Application Steps:

- Complete the online application form.
- Upload all required documents and supporting permits.
- Allow up to 10 business days for review and processing.
- Track the status of your permit anytime through your online portal account.

Permit Fees

- \$250 — Permit Fee due at the time of application.
- Additional fees may apply as determined by the City of Gulf Shores.
