- 1. All contestants must be currently attending a Baldwin County Public/Private School or homeschooled in the Baldwin County area.
- 2. All contestants will be assigned a number by the pageant committee.
- 3. Winners are selected by a point system.
- 4. Judging is based on poise, appearance and personality.
- 5. Judges' decisions are final.
- 6. Parents/Guardians and contestants should not approach the judges or ask about judging.
- 7. Contestants are expected to follow directions of pageant workers.
- 8. Contestants are required to show respect to all pageant workers and fellow contestants.
- 9. Contestants will exhibit good sportsmanship throughout the pageant.
- 10. Contestants will present in the holding room by the time stated in the contestant information.
- 11. Parents will not be allowed back stage once pageant starts.
- 12. Parents will not be allowed to contact contestants during pageant.
- 13. No dressing rooms are available. Contestants MUST be fully dressed upon arrival.
- 14. No glitter is allowed in hair or makeup.
- 15. Little Miss Zydeco Queens will be required to attend the Zydeco Crawfish Festival on April 20th.
- 16. Queens will return to the 2020 pageant to crown the new Queens.
- 17. Video cameras are allowed, however, they put be set up in the back of the building. Cameras and phones can be used but must be kept at a lower level.
- 18. The Gulf Shores Civic Center does not allow outside food or drinks.
- 19. ALL ISLAND FLOWERS will be present Thursday at rehearsal and Friday at the pageant for anyone to purchase flowers.
