City of Gulf Shores hosts Meyer Park Playground Grand Opening on April 11

Gulf Shores, Ala – April 3, 2019 – The City of Gulf Shores is excited to announce the Grand Opening and Ribbon Cutting Ceremony for the updated Meyer Park Playground on Thursday, April 11, at 5:30 p.m.

The goal of the Meyer Park Improvement Project was to improve and reconfigure the existing Meyer Park playground area. The project included replacing the playground, pouring new sidewalks with benches and re-sodding open areas near the pavilion and restrooms. The park also features new recycling containers, as part of the City-wide recycling initiative.

“We are very pleased with the outcome of the Meyer Park Improvement Project,” Recreation & Cultural Affairs Assistant Director Matt Young said. “Our primary focus was to provide a safe and enjoyable area for our kids to play.
