STATE OF ALABAMA COVID-19 RETAIL REGULATIONS

Effective June 30, 2020, all retail establishments shall operate under the guidelines provided in the current State of Alabama Public Health Order issued by Governor Kay Ivey in response to the Coronavirus pandemic.

These state-wide regulations are enforced by the Baldwin County Health Department and the City of Gulf Shores:

- **50% Maximum Occupancy:** Occupancy shall be limited to no more than 50 percent of the normal occupancy load as determined by the fire marshal. This “emergency maximum occupancy rate” shall be posted in a conspicuous place, and enough staff shall be posted at the store entrances and exits to enforce this requirement.
- **Social Distancing:** An employee of the retail store may not knowingly allow customers or patrons to congregate within six (6) feet of a person from another household.
- **Sanitation:** The retail store shall take reasonable steps to comply with guidelines on sanitation from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the Alabama Department of Public Health.

Businesses who refuse to comply with social distancing requirements are subject to a fine of up to \$500, or suspension of their business license.
